EXPANDING YOUR PAYCHECK: BENEFITS AND SERVICES TO CONSIDER

You may be eligible for the following benefits and services to help workers make their paychecks go farther.

- **EARNED INCOME CREDIT**

You may be eligible for a tax refund if you if you make less than \$56,000 a year. For more information, visit www.irs.gov (search for EIC).

- **HEALTH INSURANCE FOR CHILDREN**

Your state offers health care insurance for children. Eligibility and services vary by state. For more information, visit www.insurekidsnow.gov or call 1-877-Kids-Now.

- **SNAP/FOOD STAMPS**

Find out about assistance for buying food. Benefits are determined by family size, income and expenses. For more information, visit www.fns.usda.gov/snap.

- **FREE TAX PREPARATION**
